

Publications by Daniel J. Harrington, S.J. (1961-2013)

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This bibliography is as complete as I could make it. However, it does not include my contributions to *New Testament Abstracts* (ca. 50,000 abstracts of articles, and ca. 25,000 book notices), my editing of the *Sacra Pagina* commentary series on the New Testament (18 volumes), and my “Word” essays in *America* between 2005 and 2008 (more than 150 articles on the Sunday Scripture readings). A few frequent abbreviations: *CBQ* = *Catholic Biblical Quarterly*; *JBL* = *Journal of Biblical Literature*; and *TS* = *Theological Studies*.

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
